## ORDER OF DISMISSAL

The proceeding was initiated by the filing by Adams Delivery Service, Inc. (Adams) of a protest and request for suspension and investigation of Rate Reduction (RR) 522 filed on August 21, 1981 by Lawlor Motor Express, Inc. (Lawlor) to become effective September 23, 1981. Lawlor filed its response to Adams's protest on September 18, 1981.

After review of the allegations set forth in the protest and in the response, it was concluded that RR 522 was filed in conformance with the Commission's motor carrier rate reregulation plan set forth in Decision (D.) 90663. (See also D.93521 dated September 1, 1981 in OII 92, involving RR 436 of Lawlor.) The rates in RR 522 became effective September 23, 1981. In the circumstances, the issues raised in (I&S)
