ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Ordering Paragraph 3 of Decision (D.) 92497 directed Southern California Gas Company (SoCal) to submit by July 1, 1981 a more rigorous methodology for projecting conservation goals for its programs. The submission is to include an evaluation of effective market saturation and goals for achieving such saturation. D.93040, dated May 19, 1981, extended the filing date to October 1, 1981.

SoCal by letter dated October 2, 1981, has requested a 45-day extension of time to November 15, 1981 for complying with Ordering Paragraph 3. SoCal states that although the methodology for projecting goals has been completed, repetitive model runs necessary to develop and verify information necessary to estimate achievable conservation goals are expected to be completed by November 15, 1981.


SoCal's request is reasonable and will be granted. SoCal has served a copy of its letter on all parties and no protests have been received.
