ORDER CORRECTING CLERICAL ERROR

Decision (D.) 92792 dated March 17, 1981 established a natural gas tariff rate for electrical generation by cogenerators.

By inadvertent error Finding 16 incorrectly referenced our investigation establishing natural gas priorities as Case 9462. To avoid confusion this error should be corrected and Finding 16 revised.

IT IS ORDERED that Finding 16 of D. 92792 is revised as follows: A.59459 et al. ALJ/ec

16. By D. 92704 (February 18, 1981) in Case 9642 we adopted a P-3A priority for cogeneration facilities and said we would describe which cogeneration volumes would qualify for higher priorities. It is reasonable that all natural gas used by cogenerators in the sequential production of electricity and steam, heat, or useful work should qualify for higher priorities. This order is issued under Resolution A-4661. This order is effective today. Dated December 1, 1981, at San Francisco, California.
