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BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

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Application of R. S. Greitz, on behalf of Dreisbach Enterprises. Inc. for authority to cancel the carrier's participation from tariffs issued by Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc. and for Dreisbach Enterprises, Inc. to adopt and establish as its own rates and rules of Pacific Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc. tariffs.

Shortened Procedure Tariff Docket Application 60986 (Filed October 15, 1981)

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For authority to depart from the terms of Sections 454, 461.5 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code when accomplishing such publication.

<u>O P I N I O N</u>

By this application, Dreisbach Enterprises, Inc. seeks authority to transfer its participation from tariffs issued by Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc. (WMTB), to tariffs published by Pacific Motor Tariff Bureau (PMTB).

Due to inherent differences between tariffs issued by WMTB and tariffs issued by PMTB, increases would result from the transfer. Applicant has determined that it would be in its best interest to transfer from tariffs of WMTB to those of PMTB.

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In no event would the increases in gross revenue derived from California intrastate traffic be as much as 1%.

The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of October 15, 1981. No objection to the granting of the application has been received.

Findings of Fact

1. Increases resulting from this proposal are justified.

2. The following order has no reasonably foreseeable impact upon the energy efficiency of highway carriers.

3. A public hearing is not necessary.

Conclusion of Law

The proposed transfer of tariffs governing applicant's rates is just and reasonable and the application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Dreisbach Enterprises, Inc. is authorized to have its participation canceled from tariffs issued by Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., and have its participation added to certain tariffs published by Pacific Motor Tariff Bureau as specifically proposed in the application.

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2. Tariff publications authorized to be made as a result of this order shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be effective not earlier than 5 days after the effective date of this order on not less than 5 days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

3. The authorized cancellation of applicant's participation in Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc. tariff publications shall be concurrent with the effective date of the authorized adoption of Pacific Motor Tariff Bureau's tariff publications.

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4. The authority granted shall expire unless exercised within 90 days after the effective date of this order.

This order becomes effective 30 days from today.
