ORDER CORRECTING NOTICE

By Decision (D.) 93774, dated November 23, 1981, the Commission in special session ordered the Southern California Gas Company to send a notice to certain applicants for loans under its demonstration solar water heating program regarding modification of that program.

Through inadvertence, the notice appended to D.93774 contains language which inaccurately describes the action the Commission had taken in ordering paragraph number 1. To correct this inconsistency, pursuant to Resolution No. A-4661,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The third sentence of paragraph 1 of the notice appended to D.93774 is hereby amended in part to read as follows:

"...the Public Utilities Commission ordered in D.93774 that as of November 23, 1981, SoCal Gas stop sending out new offers to enter into low interest loans to applicants requesting loans in excess of four thousand dollars (\$4,000) for solar water heating system."
