It has come to our attention that certain language which we intended to include in Decision (D.) 93725 was inadvertently omitted.

Under Resolution A-4661,

IT IS ORDERED that:


1. The following paragraph should appear on page 32 of that decision:

On this date we have issued D.93726 in A.59818 et al. reanalyzing our opinion of "common carriage". That decision makes the issuance of a certificate to a carrier engaged 100% in roundtrip sight-seeing unnecessary. Recognizing that the decision may be the subject of further review, we will as a precaution issue Pacifico its certificate, since public need for the service is established.

2. In all other respects, D.93725 remains in full force and effect.
