ORDER EXTENDING TIME

On December 1, 1981 The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company moved for an extension of time of 120 days from December 8 for submission of a proposed general order on the installation and maintenance of private lines used by the alarm industry as required by Ordering Paragraph 3.c. of Decision (D.) 93367 dated August 4, 1981.

The Western Burglar and Fire Alarm Association (WBFA), the only other party actively engaged in developing the proposed general order, joined in the motion but prefers to have the time extended only 90 days. WBFA claims good progress has been made and its clients are anxious to have the standards developed and put into effect.

We find a 90-day extension is reasonable and conclude that it should be granted. Because December 8, the current deadline, has passed this order should be effective today.
