ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This application was filed on April 13, 1981. It was filed in pro se, but applicant has at times been represented by counsel.

On June 12, 1981, the assigned administrative law judge (ALJ) wrote to applicant's counsel and indicated that the application could not be processed because of specified deficiencies and that an amendment was required. A copy of the letter was sent to applicant. There was no response to the letter.

On July 23, 1981, the Gray Line Inc. (Gray Line) filed a Petition for Leave To File Protest with an accompanying affidavit and tendered protest. The petition was granted and the protest filed. On July 27, 1981, Gray Line filed a Motion to Dismiss the application.

On September 23, 1981, the assigned ALJ wrote to applicant's counsel that unless an amended pleading was filed by October 30, 1981, he would recommend that the application be dismissed. A copy of the letter was sent to the applicant. On October 1, 1981, counsel responded stating that he no longer represented the applicant. No amended pleading has been filed.

The Commission finds and concludes that the application should be dismissed for lack of prosecution.


IT IS ORDERED that Application 60444 is dismissed for lack of prosecution.
