ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Application (A.) 91-02-032 was filed in 1991 seeking an alternative means of determining appropriate rates for transportation of property in California by highway contract carriers. As of January 1, 1995, the authority of this Commission to regulate the price, route, or service of highway contract carriers has been preempted by new Federal legislation (P.L. 103-305).

As a consequence of this legislation, the Administrative Law Judge directed a letter dated July 13, 1995 to counsel for applicant, with a copy to all parties in A.91-02-032. This letter asked whether there was any point in continuing this matter on our docket. We have received no response, and therefore assume that there is no longer any interest in the application.
