ORDER OF DISMISSAL

An examination of the Commission's records disclosed that there were three dockets pertaining to Minimum Rate Tariff (MRT) 4-B that were still open. MRT 4-B was superseded by MRT 4-C, which, in turn, was superseded by maximum rate tariffs, pursuant to Decision 92-05-028.

Notice of our intent to dismiss the open dockets was published in the Commission's Daily Calendar beginning September 3, 1996, and daily thereafter. In addition, individual copies of this calendar were sent to tariff bureaus, agents, and trucking publications and associations. The calendar notice listed the dockets under consideration for dismissal for mootness. It also gave all concerned until October 1, 1996 to notify Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Rosenthal of any reason why dismissal should not occur.

As of October 1, 1996, no party to any of these dockets had contacted the ALJ. We shall therefore assume that there is no further purpose in having these dockets remain open and dismiss them as moot.

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IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Case (C.) 5330, OSH 120; C.5433, OSH 78; and C.5437, OSH 26 are found to be moot and are dismissed.
- 2. This order is to be printed in full in the Commission's Daily Calendar for one week following its effective date.
