OPINION

Background

This application, filed by Reliable Stage Lines, Inc. on November 18, 1996, requested a hearing to contest the suspension of its operating authorities. The Commission suspended applicant's passenger stage certificate (PSC-9791) and its charter-party carrier certificate (TCP-9791B) at the request of the California Highway Patrol (CHP) in accordance with Public Utilities Code Sections 1033.7 and 5378.5.

Prior to the scheduled hearing, the Commission received a recommendation for reinstatement of operating authority by the CHP, due to a satisfactory reinspection by the CHP.

The Commission cancelled the scheduled hearing and reinstated applicant's operating authorities effective November 22. 1996.

Discussion

Since applicant's operating authorities have been reinstated, this proceeding is moot. The application should be dismissed.

Finding of Fact

Applicant's operating authorities have been reinstated. Conclusion of Law

This application should be dismissed as moot.
