OPINION

ORIGINAL

Background

This application, filed by Goodall's Charter Bus Service, Inc. on January 17, 1997, requested a hearing to contest the suspension of its operating authorities. The Commission suspended applicant's charter-party carrier certificate (TCP 111) at the request of the California Highway Patrol (CHP) in accordance with Public Utilities Code § 5378.5.

Prior to scheduling a hearing in this matter, the Commission received a recommendation for reinstatement of operating authority by the CHP, due to a satisfactory reinspection by the CHP.

The Commission reinstated applicant's operating authorities effective January 24, 1997.

Discussion

Since applicant's operating authorities have been reinstated, this proceeding is moot. The application should be dismissed.

Finding of Fact

Applicant's operating authorities have been reinstated.

Conclusion of Law

This application should be dismissed as moot.

1. Application 97-01-021 is dismissed.
