TWENTY-EIGHTH INTERIM OPINION

The Commission opened Investigation (I.) 89-12-025 in 1989 to review lengthy service outages at Palo Verde Nuclear Generating Station, which is owned in part by Southern California Edison Company (Edison). The investigation was consolidated with Edison's test year 1992 general rate case, in compliance with Public Utilities Code § 455.5(c), and was identified as Phase 3 of the proceeding. In Decision 95-05-042, the Commission adopted a settlement between Edison and the Division of Ratepayer Advocates, which completed Phase 3. Because there are no outstanding issues, 1.89-12-025 can be closed.

Finding of Fact

There are no outstanding issues in Phase 3.

Conclusion of Law

1.89-12-025 should be closed.
