O P I N I O N

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) filed this application seeking modification of Resolution G-3062 on September 9, 1993. Its application seeks to remove the requirement for utility electric generators and qualifying facilities to be provided "service level parity" and to replace it with a policy to provide "class average rates" to qualifying facilities. Resolution G-3062 implemented certain gas policies adopted in Decision (D.) 91-11-025 and D.92-07-025. At the time of filing this application, SoCalGas also filed petitions to modify those two orders with regard to the same issue. Southern California Edison Company and the California Cogeneration Council filed protests to the application.

This order denies SoCalGas' application on the basis that, with the passage of time, this matter has been addressed in other forums. It is therefore appropriate to close this proceeding.

Finding of Fact

The issue raised in this application has been addressed in other forums.

Conclusion of Law

Application 93-09-028 should be closed.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Southern California Gas Company's application for modification of Resolution G-3062 is denied as set forth herein.
2. Application 93-09-028 is closed.
