O P I N I O N

The application in this matter, a standard request for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a switchless reseller of interLATA and intraLATA services within California, was filed on December 18, 1995.

On March 7, 1996, the assigned Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) spoke with applicant's representative and informed the representative that the application was deficient in several respects, including failure to demonstrate that applicant, a Texas corporation, was qualified to do business in California. The ALJ asked that the deficiencies be corrected promptly, so that the application could be processed.

On May 23, 1996, the assigned ALJ issued a Ruling describing the above-noted deficiencies, and stating that unless the deficiencies were corrected within 30 days, the application would be dismissed. Since that time, there has been no communication between applicant and the ALJ, and the missing information has not been supplied.

Under these circumstances, it is appropriate to dismiss the application for lack of prosecution.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The application is dismissed without prejudice.
2. Application 95-12-055 is closed.

This order is effective today.
