Summary

Order dismissing application as state.

Discussion

This matter was filed in 1991 in order to get Commission approval of a rate increase to cover the costs of joining the Montevina Pipeline project. This project was to bring an assured, safe supply of water to Idylwild. The application requested to place a surcharge on the customers for a limited time to cover the costs of membership in the project until such time as water was actually received. The surcharge was granted for nine months by Decision (D.) 91-07-046. In that decision the Commission stated that the project.

Idylwild filed a petition to modify D.91-07-046 to permit additional surcharges for six months. This was granted by D.92-12-064. Since that time there has been no further entries in this docket. We believe that there is no longer a reason to keep this docket open. Should there be a need for some rate adjustment, it can be considered in a new filing.

Findings of Fact

1. This docket was left open in D.91-07-046 as a vehicle to cover possible rate adjustments as result of improvements and the costs thereof.
