**OPINION**

**Summary**

Order dismissing the proceeding.

**Discussion**

On July 7, 1992, a complaint was filed asking that defendant Craig Pierce be prevented from terminating water sales to San Martin Water Works, Inc. Also joined in the complaint was Robert Ukestad, listed as owner and operator of West San Martin Water Works, Inc. The complaint alleged a threat to the health and safety of the community of San Martin if the sales were terminated.

By Decision (D.) 92-07-073, dated July 22, 1992, the Commission issued a temporary restraining order against Pierce ordering him to reconnect his well and continue to serve customers of San Martin Water Works, Inc. This order was rescinded by D.92-09-033. The Commission has held this matter open in case further hearings proved necessary. It is now time to terminate this matter.

**Findings of Fact**

1. A temporary restraining order was issued in response to the complaint in this matter.

3. The file discloses no further communication with the Commission on this matter.

**Conclusion of Law**
