FINAL OPINION

The Commission opened this proceeding to review the earnings claims of Pacific Gas and Electric Company, Southern California Gas Company, Southern California

Edison Company, and San Diego Gas & Electric Company for their 1993 demand-side management (DSM) activities. By Decision (D.) 94-12-021, the Commission authorized earnings for 1993 DSM activities and made certain refinements and clarifications to previously adopted measurement and evaluation protocols. The proceeding was left open to so that the Commission Advisory and Compliance Division (CACD) could incorporate the adopted modifications into the existing protocols and file the most current version of measurement and evaluation protocols in this docket. CACD made this filing on February 15, 1995. Because there are no outstanding issues, this proceeding can be closed.
