### OPINION

This application requests authority to transfer the certificate of convenience and necessity of Anthony T. and Delores E. Montana to MONTAFAM Corporation. The application as filed has a number of deficiencies. On October 14, 1994, a letter from the assigned administrative law judge was sent to applicants requesting the following necessary information to allow processing of the application.

- articles of incorporation of MONTAFAM Corporation;
- a financial statement of the corporation;
- the reason for the transfer; and
- the current balance sheet of transferor.

No response and no information was received.

Therefore, this application will be dismissed for lack of prosecution.

## Findings of Fact

- 1. The application as filed is deficient.
- 2. Applicant has not responded with the additional required information to allow processing of the application.

# Conclusions of law

- 1. The application cannot be processed as filed.
- 2. The application should be dismissed for lack of prosecution.
  - 3. This proceeding should be closed.
