**ORIGINAL****OPINION**

Applicant Madonna Construction Company filed this application on April 8, 1993, seeking a hearing regarding the suspension of its operating authority. Applicant's suspension, caused by an unsatisfactory inspection by the California Highway Patrol (CHP), was effective March 16, 1993. The CHP withdrew its recommendation for suspension after satisfactory reinspection on April 21, 1993.

Applicant's operating authority was subsequently revoked by the Commission due to failure to maintain evidence of insurance on file at the Commission.

No hearing was held. This application should be dismissed as moot and closed.

**Findings of Fact**

1. Applicant's operating authority was suspended as a result of an unsatisfactory inspection by the CHP.
2. Applicant's operating authority was revoked by the Commission.
3. No hearing was held.
4. Applicant has not sought reinstatement of operating authority after revocation.

**Conclusions of Law**

1. This application should be dismissed.
2. This proceeding should be closed.

**O R D E R**

**IT IS ORDERED** that:

1. Application 93-04-012 is dismissed.
2. This proceeding is closed.
