O P I N I O N

Applicant M. Van Vliet & Sons, Inc. filed this application for hearing on February 10, 1993, due to a suspension of applicant's operating authority on December 15, 1992, at the request of the California Highway Patrol (CHP), due to failure to meet CHP safety requirements. Reinspection of applicant's facilities by the CHP was satisfactory, and applicant's authority was reinstated effective August 30, 1993.

Applicant withdrew the request for hearing by letter dated February 17, 1993. No hearing was held. The application for hearing should be dismissed as moot.

Findings of Fact

1. Applicant's authority was suspended as a result of a failed inspection by the CHP.
2. Authority was reinstated after satisfactory reinspection by the CHP.
3. Applicant withdrew the request for hearing.
4. The application is moot.

Conclusions of Law

1. The application should be dismissed as moot.
2. This proceeding should be closed.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Application 93-02-019 is dismissed.
2. This proceeding is closed.
