Summary

Proceeding dismissed as stale.

Discussion

This was a proceeding initiated to change the basis for charges used in Distance Table 8 from constructive miles to postal zip code areas. A review of our files indicates that the last docket entry in this proceeding was a proposed decision by retired Administrative Law Judge Lemke filed on November 4, 1988. There have been no formal inquiries as to the status of this matter.

It is clear that the material in this record is now stale and should not be used for a current decision. Therefore, we shall dismiss this proceeding without prejudice.
