ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Applicant Morris D. Williams, et al., doing business as Yuba Sutter Transportation Airport Service (Yuba Sutter), filed this petition on June 13, 1994, to abandon all operations. Yuba Sutter is a partnership holding a certificate as a passenger stage corporation PSC 8291. Applicant states that the reason for the request to abandon service is lack of ridership, availability of essentially the same service by other agencies at lower cost, and inability to retain a driver due to low ridership. To continue the service would impose a financial hardship on Yuba Sutter.

Applicant apparently had abandoned service, and on July 5, 1994, Yuba Sutter's authority was revoked for failure to maintain evidence of insurance on file at the Commission.

The issues in the application are moot, and it should be dismissed.

Findings of Fact

1. Applicant requests authority to abandon all operations.
2. Yuba Sutter's authority was revoked due to lack of evidence of insurance on file at the Commission.

Conclusions of Law

1. This application should be dismissed.
2. This proceeding should be closed.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Application 94-06-021 is dismissed.
2. This proceeding is closed.
