## **OPINION**

In Decision (D.) 90-11-021 (November 9, 1990), the Commission approved a stipulation of settlement of this Order Instituting Investigation (OII) and closed this proceeding. On December 22, 1992, the predecessor to our Rail Safety and Consumer Services Divisions (RSD/CSD) filed a motion for issuance of a final order of revocation of operating authority (motion). The Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) treated the motion as encompassing a petition to modify D.90-11-021. Respondent was given 30 days to respond.

Although the original OII named only Mike's Rapid Service, Inc. (Mike's) as a respondent, RSD/CSD sought relief against the two officers and sole shareholder of Mike's in its motion. On January 7, 1993, the ALJ directed RSD/CSD to file a memo of points and authorities supporting the existence of such authority no later than January 22, 1993. Respondent was given 15 days thereafter to respond. RSD/CSD was also ordered to file and serve a declaration under penalty of perjury by a prescient employee of this Commission that fines and monies required by Ordering Paragraphs 1 and 3 of D.90-11-021 were not paid timely by Mike's.

Due to settlement negotiations between RSD/CSD and Mike's, the memo and declaration were not filed. Although requested to make further filings regarding the status of the motion and OII, RSD/CSD has failed so to do. Therefore, we will deny the

motion and petition to modify without prejudice and order this Oll remain a closed docket under Ordering Paragraph 5 of D.90-11-021.

## ORDER

## IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. The motion of the predecessor to our Rail Safety and Consumer Services

  Divisions for issuance of a final order of revocation of operating authority for cause and
  the related petition to modify Decision 90-11-021 are denied without prejudice.
  - 2. Investigation 89-09-006 is closed.

This order is effective today.
