ORDER CORRECTING ERROR

Due to an error an incorrect dollar figure was included in the first paragraph of Decision 97-10-049, mailed on October 22, 1997. Paragraph 1 of this decision reads:

"This decision grants The Utility Reform Network (TURN) an award of \$74,424.75 in compensation for its contribution to Decision (D.) 96-09-089, in which the Commission found that GTE California, Incorporated (GTEC) and Pacific Bell (Pacific) had yet failed to demonstrate that local exchange competition, and the new rules allowing such competition, constitute a taking."

Therefore, pursuant to the authority granted in Resolution A-4661, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Paragraph 1 of D.97-10-049 is corrected to read:

"This decision grants The Utility Reform Network (TURN) an award of \$76,788 in compensation for its contribution to Decision (D.) 96-09-089, in which the Commission found that GTE California, Incorporated (GTEC) and Pacific Bell (Pacific) had yet failed to demonstrate that local exchange
