O P I N I O N

The Commission issued decisions granting interim authority to Pacific Bell, Contel of California, Inc., and GTE California Incorporated to provide certain new privacy-related Custom Local Access Signaling Services (CLASS) features June 17, 1992, and November 23, 1992.¹ The authority was conditioned on the carriers implementing Customer Notice and Education Programs (CNEPs) about the privacy implications of certain CLASS features. These dockets remained open to consider related requests for compensation and motions regarding the implementation of the CNEPs.

The requests for compensation were addressed in D.93-01-015 and D.93-10-045. The motions regarding the implementation of the CNEPs were addressed by rulings of July 18, 1995, and July 22, 1996. Other implementation issues were presented in Advice Letter filings and ruled on by the Commission in resolutions.²

It appears all outstanding issues have been addressed. We therefore close this proceeding.

Findings of Fact

1. By D.92-06-065, D.92-11-062, D.93-01-015 and D.93-10-045, applicants were granted conditional, interim authority to offer certain new privacy-related CLASS features, and related requests for compensation. Motions regarding implementation were addressed by rulings of July 18, 1995, and July 22, 1996.

2. All outstanding issues have been addressed.

Conclusion of Law

The Commission should close Application (A.) 90-11-011, A.90-12-065, and A.91-01-039.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that Application (A.) 90-11-011, A.90-12-065, and A.91-01-039 are closed.
