O P I N I O N

Background

On February 4, 1997, the Commission's Consumer Services Division (CSD) filed its Motion to Compel Compliance and Convene Prehearing Conference (Motion). In the Motion, CSD stated that the Alco Water Corporation was not in compliance with Commission Decision (D.) 95-02-083 in that water service had not been extended to property owned by the complainant. CSD sought an order of the Commission compelling such compliance and requested that a prehearing conference (PHC) be scheduled.

On April 4, 1997, the assigned Administrative Law Judge issued a ruling stating that the Chief Administrative Law Judge had docketed CSD's Motion as a Petition to Modify Decision 95-02-083. A prehearing conference was held on April 14, 1997, at which the parties reached an agreement to resolve the issues raised by CSD.

The agreed-upon actions have been taken and CSD states that Alco is now in compliance with D.95-02-083 and related Commission regulations. For this reason, CSD requests authorization to withdraw its petition.

CSD served its request on all parties. No party filed a response.

Discussion

CSD's request is granted for the reasons stated in its withdrawal request.

Findings of Fact

1. CSD has stated that Alco is in compliance with D.95-02-083.
2. CSD has requested authorization to withdraw its petition to modify which re-opened this docket.

Conclusions of Law

1. No issues remain to be resolved in this docket.
2. This docket should be closed.

O R D E R

Therefore **IT IS ORDERED** that Consumer Services Division's Petition to Modify Decision 95-02-083 is withdrawn and this docket is closed.
