ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On May 8, 1997, the Commission's Rail Safety/Carriers Division (staff) sent a letter to the applicants requesting that they clarify and provide additional information concerning the bus stops on their proposed scheduled stops. Staff also requested that the applicants: (1) clarify the equipment they propose to operate, (2) specify the number of drivers, and (3) serve copies of their application to the Cities of San Francisco and Los Angeles affected by their proposed service.

A second letter, dated October 2, 1997, addressed to the applicants indicated that staff would recommend to the Commission that the application be dismissed if the requested amendment was not filed by October 31. Applicants have not responded.

Findings of Fact

1. This application is procedurally defective for the following reasons:
 - a. The bus stops are not described.
 - b. The equipment for the proposed service is not clear and a list of drivers to be employed for the proposed route are not provided.
 - c. The applicants failed to service copies of the application to all the cities and governmental agencies affected by their proposed service.
2. Staff advised applicants by letter on two separate occasions that the application is defective and should be amended.
3. Applicants have failed to respond to staff's letter and file the amended application.

Conclusion of Law

This application should be dismissed due to applicants' failure to pursue it.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Application 97-04-037, filed by Genadiy Spektor and Kirill Mogilev, is dismissed effective today.

2. This application is closed.
