ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Discussion

On September 15, 1997, the Commission's Rail Safety and Carriers Division (staff) sent a letter to the applicant to clarify and provide additional information concerning its proposed operations. The staff requested applicant to describe how it proposes to operate as a passenger stage corporation as defined in Public Utilities (PU) Code § 226.

A second letter, dated January 20, 1998, addressed to the applicant said that the staff will recommend to the Commission that it dismiss the application if the requested amendment was not filed by February 4, 1998. Applicant has not responded.

Findings of Fact

1. This application is procedurally defective in that it fails to describe the proposed operations.
2. Staff advised applicant by letter on two separate occasions that the application is defective and should be amended.
3. Applicant has failed to respond to the staff's letters and file the amended application.

Conclusion of Law

This application should be dismissed due to applicant's failure to pursue it.
IT IS ORDERED that Application 97-08-014 filed by Xpress Management Systems LLC, dba Xpress Shuttle, is dismissed effective today.

Application 97-08-014 is closed.
