O P I N I O N

Findings of Fact

1. Saddiq Khan files this complaint requesting flat rate service and removal of a utility pole.
2. This complaint is identical to that filed by Saddiq Khan against Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) in Case (C.) 95-10-051 and dismissed by Decision (D.) 96-07-012, July 3, 1996. Case 95-10-051 was dismissed because complainant was shown not to be the utility's customer of record and had no authority to represent the customer of record. Also, the utility pole of which complaint is made was found by the Commission's Utilities Safety Branch to be in compliance with General Order 95. PG&E has repeatedly offered to underground or reconstruct the high-voltage line carried by the pole at complainant's expense and in coordination with the utility's customer of record.
3. The complaint alleges no new facts.
4. Defendant answered this complaint stating that there is no change in the facts leading to D.96-07-012 and requesting that C.97-10-060 be dismissed with prejudice.

Conclusion of Law

The complaint should be dismissed with prejudice.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Case 97-10-060 is dismissed with prejudice.
2. This docket is closed.
