**BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

In the Matter of the Application of Samia Shabaan a sole proprietor, doing business as EZ Way Out Shuttle, for authority to operate as a passenger stage corporation on call between points in the San Francisco, San Mateo, Alameda, Contra Costa, Stanislaus, San Joaquin, and Santa Clara Counties and the San Jose, Oakland, and San Francisco International Airports, and between Berkeley, Emeryville and Oakland and the Oakland International Airport, San Francisco International Airport on scheduled.

**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

**Discussion**

On August 22, 1997, the Commission's Rail Safety and Carriers Division (staff) sent a letter to the applicant, Samia Shabaan, to clarify and provide additional information concerning the proposed service areas, fares, and her assertions in paragraphs X and XII that if the Commission grants the requested authority she "will ask the commission to revoke her existing PSC certificate. The existing authority will be covered by the requested certificate."

A second letter, dated January 20, 1998, informed the applicant that the staff will recommend to the Commission that it dismiss the application if the requested clarification was not filed by February 4, 1998. Applicant has not responded.

**Findings of Fact**

1. This application is procedurally defective as the requested proposed service areas and fares are not clear.

2. Staff advised applicant by letter on two separate occasions that the application is defective and should be amended.
3. Applicant has failed to respond to the staff's letters and file the amended application.

**Conclusion of Law**

This application should be dismissed due to applicant's failure to pursue it.

**IT IS ORDERED** that:

1. Application 97-07-045 filed by Samia Shabaan, dba EZ Way Out Shuttle, is dismissed effective today.
2. Application 97-07-045 is closed.
