ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Discussion

On September 5, 1995, the Commission's then Safety and Enforcement Division, Compliance and Enforcement Branch (staff) visited Kristyna D. Gibson (applicant) at her residence in Santa Cruz to discuss the applicant's operations and review her records. Her parents, Eileen Jahnke and Ronald Jahnke, informed the staff that the applicant had moved her business to Phoenix, Arizona, had ceased operations in California, and no longer desired to obtain a passenger stage authority from this Commission. This conversation was confirmed in the staff's letter of October 5, 1995 to Applicant. Applicant has not responded.

Finding of Fact

Applicant has failed to respond to staff's letter.

Conclusion of Law

This application should be dismissed due to applicant's failure to pursue it.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Application 95-07-021 filed by Kristyna D. Gibson, dba Precious Cargo, is dismissed effective today.
