**ORDER DENYING REHEARING OF RESOLUTION G-3095**

Enron Access Corporation (EAC) filed an application for rehearing of Resolution G-3095 on March 7, 1994. In this resolution, the Commission denied the request of Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas), presented in Advice Letter 2213-G, to extend the deadline for trading transportation imbalances for EAC and Lockheed Corporation.

In its application, EAC presents its view of the pertinent facts of the matter, but fails to identify legal error in the resolution which would require rehearing. (See Cal.Pub.Util. Code Section 1732.) A contrary opinion on a policy determination, as was made in Resolution G-3095, does not suffice.

Further, since the filing of the application by EAC, the issue presented has become moot.
