### ORDER EXTENDING STAY

In this enforcement proceeding, we made our Decision (D.98-05-019) effective thirty days from the date of issuance of the decision in order to allow respondent, whose certificate of public convenience and necessity we had revoked, an opportunity to invoke the automatic stay provision of Public Utilities Code Section 1733 by timely filing an application for rehearing. North Shuttle Service, Inc. filed an application for rehearing on May 27, 1998, thereby automatically staying our decision until 60 days after the date of its filing the application for rehearing or until the date upon which we render our decision on rehearing, whichever occurs first.

Absent Commission action, the automatic stay will expire on July 26, 1998. In our judgment an extension of the stay is appropriate to suspend the effective

date of our order, in order to provide us with an opportunity to fully and fairly resolve the questions presented for our review in the application for rehearing.

Good cause appearing, we now stay, sua sponte, the effective date of D.98-05-019 for an additional ninety days until October 24, 1998, or until the date upon which we render our decision on rehearing, whichever occurs first.

**IT IS ORDERED that:**

The effective date of D.98-05-019 is hereby stayed until October 24, 1998, or until the date upon which we render our decision on rehearing, whichever occurs first.

This order is effective today.
