
**ORDER DISMISSING APPLICATION FOR REHEARING
OF DECISION 96-12-075**

San Luis Obispo County and the San Luis Coastal Unified School District (County & District) filed the instant application for rehearing of Decision (D.) 96-12-075 on January 22, 1997. No other party filed an application for rehearing of D.96-12-075 and no party responded to the application for rehearing. (Cf. Pub. Util. Code, §§ 1731(b), 1732.) By letter to the Executive Director dated June 9, 1998 the County & District requested that the application for rehearing be withdrawn. (This letter is attached as an Appendix to this order.)

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT, upon written request of the filing parties, the application for rehearing of D.96-12-075 filed by San Luis

Obispo County and the San Luis Coastal Unified School District is dismissed under Public Utilities Code Section 308 and Resolution A-4638, effective today.


Re: San Luis Obispo County Application for Rehearing of D.96-12-075
