

Decision 98-09-008 September 3, 1998

**BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

In the Matter of the Application of Ellen Chiang, a sole proprietorship, dba Kids Ride, for certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between points in the Pasadena, San Gabriel, West Covina, Covina, and San Dimas areas in County of Los Angeles.

**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

**Discussion**

On March 28, 1997, the Commission's Rail Safety and Carriers Division (staff) sent a letter to the applicant, Ellen Chiang, requesting her to describe the boundaries of the service area, structure the fares between points, and specify the stop points for the proposed scheduled service.

A second letter was sent on March 24, 1998 requesting the above information. When the applicant did not respond, a third letter was sent on May 15, 1998 warning that the staff would recommend dismissal of the application if a response was not received by June 15, 1998. The applicant has not responded to the staff's letters.

**Finding of Fact**

Applicant has failed to provide additional information requested by staff.

**Conclusion of Law**

This application should be dismissed due to applicant's failure to pursue it.

**IT IS ORDERED that:**

1. Application 97-03-013, filed by Ellen Chiang, dba Kids Ride, is dismissed.
2. This proceeding is closed.
