Therefore, pursuant to Resolution A-4661,


**IT IS ORDERED** that the error in D.98-05-018 is corrected as follows:

Change Ordering Paragraph 4, as follows:

"In consultation with the Low-Income Governing Board (LIGB), the interim utility administrators for low-income assistance programs shall develop 1999 program plans and budgets to be filed at the Commission as Advice Letters by October 1, 1998. The comments of LIGB and interested parties are due within 20 days thereafter."
