#### OPINION

On September 25, 1990, the Commission instituted this investigation to begin "an investigation to review existing rules, regulations, and policies on electric utility transmission services provided to nonutility producers of electricity." (Order Instituting Investigation at p. 1.)

The goals of this investigation have been met or superceded by other proceedings and events. The only outstanding issues in this case are related to the Biennial Resource Plan Update auction, and these issues are being addressed simultaneously in Investigation (I.) 89-07-004, since these two proceedings have been consolidated for several years. For these reasons, all outstanding issues in this proceeding are transferred to I.89-07-004, where the Commission is simultaneously considering them. There being no further outstanding issues in this proceeding, this proceeding is closed.

# **Findings of Fact**

- 1. The goals of this investigation have been met, or superceded by other proceedings and events.
- 2. The only outstanding issues in this case are related to the Biennial Resource Plan Update auction, and these issues are being addressed simultaneously in 1.89-07-004, since these two proceedings have been consolidated for several years.

## Conclusions of Law

- 1. All outstanding issues in this proceeding are transferred to I.89-07-004, where the Commission is simultaneously considering them.
  - 2. This proceeding should be closed.
