ORDER DISMISSING APPLICATION
OF UTILITY CONSUMERS' ACTION NETWORK
FOR REHEARING OF DECISION 97-12-041

By letter dated December 30, 1998, Utility Consumers' Action Network (UCAN) has withdrawn the application it had filed January 8, 1998 for rehearing of Decision (D.) 97-12-041. UCAN states that the issue it raised regarding an updating of the 1998 sales forecast for San Diego Gas & Electric Company's Performance-Based Ratemaking Mechanism has been mooted by subsequent decisions of the Commission. The Commission accepts UCAN's request to withdraw its rehearing application.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the application by UCAN for rehearing of D.97-12-041 be dismissed.
