

ORDER OF DISMISSAL

In its July 23, 1998 "Motion to Dismiss Complaint," MCI Telecommunications Corporation (MCI), complainant, states that on July 16, 1998 it reached agreement with defendant Pacific Bell (Pacific) that MCI should dismiss its complaint, with prejudice. MCI states its motion is not subject to the terms of Article 13.5 "Stipulations and Settlement" of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure because no prehearing conference or hearing has occurred. (Rule 51.2.)

Upon written and unopposed request of complainant Case 98-03-053 is dismissed with prejudice under Public Utilities Code § 308 and Resolution A-4638, effective today.
