ORDER EXTENDING STATUTORY DEADLINE

Public Utilities (Pub. Util.) Code § 1701.2(d) provides that adjudicatory cases shall be resolved within 12 months of initiation unless the Commission makes findings why that deadline cannot be met and issues an order extending that deadline. In this proceeding, the 12-month deadline for resolving this matter was February 4, 1999, while the Commission was still considering the crossappeals of the Presiding Officer's Decision. Therefore, an extension of the statutory deadline is needed.

Due to the § 1701.2(d) statutory deadline, there is a need to act on this matter immediately, and this constitutes an unforeseen emergency situation for purposes of Pub. Util. Code § 311(g)(2) (See Rule 81 (g) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure). Accordingly, pursuant to Pub. Util. Code § 311(g)(2), the otherwise 30-day period for public review and comment is being waived.
