Application of the City of Modesto to construct one grade crossing of the Union Pacific Railroad Company, Tidewater Line, at the Proposed Pelandale Avenue Crossing City of Modesto, State of California.

#### OPINION

The City of Modesto has moved for leave to withdraw its application in this proceeding. Protestant Union Pacific Railroad has indicated that it does not oppose the motion. The grounds for the motion are that the two parties have arrived at a stipulation which makes further action by the Commission on the application unnecessarily.

Apart from one prehearing conference, the Commission has conducted no proceedings in this matter. The Commission encourages early dispute resolution by parties to its proceedings if the result is not contrary to the public interest. Withdrawal of the present application in this proceeding is in the public interest in light of the positions articulated by the parties at the prehearing conference.

We will grant the motion.

This is an uncontested matter in which the decision grants the relief requested. Accordingly, pursuant to Pub. Util. Code § 311(g)(2), the otherwise applicable 30-day period for public review and comment is being waived.

#### Findings of Fact

1. The Applicant has filed a motion to withdraw its application.

2. The motion is not opposed by the protestant.
