

Decision 00-02-027 February 3, 2000

BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of Ms. THETA McCOMB, as the Sole Owner of GRAND VIEW GARDENS WATER COMPANY, INC., a California corporation, and AQUASOURCE UTILITY, INC., a Texas corporation, for the following orders:

1. Authorizing Theta McComb to sell and transfer to AquaSource, ownership of certain assets of Grand View Gardens Water Company, Inc., and
2. Authorizing Grand View Gardens Water Company, Inc. to withdraw from the water utility business; and
3. Authorizing AquaSource to engage in and carry on the water utility service to the customers of Grand View Gardens Water Company, Inc.
