SECTION I. GENERAL AUTHORIZATIONS, RESTRICTIONS,
LIMITATIONS, AND SPECIFICATIONS.

This certificate supersedes all passenger stage operative authorities granted to Ross A. Vitalie and Irene F. Vitalie, husband and wife.

Ross A. Vitalie, an individual, by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by the decision noted in the foot of the margin, is authorized to transport passengers and their baggage between the cities and communities, as described in Section II, and the Eureka-Arcata Airport, over and along the route described in Section III, subject, however, to the authority of this Commission to change or modify the route at any time and subject to the following provisions:

- a. When a route description is given in one direction, it applies to operation in either direction unless otherwise indicated.
- b. The term "on-call", as used, refers to service which is authorized to be rendered dependent on the demands of passengers. The tariffs and timetables shall show the conditions under which each authorized on-call service will be rendered.
- d. No passengers shall be transported except those having a point of origin or destination as described in Section IIB.
- e. This certificate does not authorize the holder to conduct any operation on the property of or into any airport unless such operation is authorized by the airport authority involved.

SECTION II. SERVICE AREA.

A. All points within the geographical limits of the following cities or communities located in Humboldt County:

Eureka, Arcata, and McKinleyville.

B. Eureka-Arcata Airport.

SECTION III. ROUTE DESCRIPTION.

Commencing from any point as described in Section II, then over the most convenient streets, expressways, and highways to the Eureka-Arcata Airport.
