ORDER CORRECTING ERRORS

The Commission has noted two nonsubstantive errors in Decision (D.) 99-09-035, which was signed September 2, 1999. The clerical errors occurred in the processing of the order after the Commission's Executive Session. This order is necessary to correct the errors.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority granted in Resolution A-4661, **IT IS ORDERED** that:

1. The first full sentence on page 6, line 2, "PG&E was instructed to pay the fines into an escrow account when the Executive Director denied the extension request," should be replaced with "PG&E was advised that it could pay the fines into an escrow account when the Executive Director denied the extension request."

2. The current language in Ordering Paragraph 2 should be omitted. Ordering Paragraph 2 should now read "PG&E's Motion to Stay the payment of the fines is denied."

This order is effective today.
