

Decision 99-10-045 October 21, 1999

**BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

Application of Inder Mohan Singh dba Buddy Shuttle Service to transfer his certificate of public convenience and necessity and all other assets to Buddy Shuttle Inc., a California corporation.

**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

**Summary**

Application to transfer a previously revoked passenger stage certificate dismissed.

**Discussion**

Inder Mohan Singh, dba Buddy Shuttle Service (Transferor) applied to transfer passenger stage certificate PSC-9003 to a newly formed corporation, Buddy Shuttle Service, Inc. (Transferee). A review of the Commission's records reveals that this certificate was revoked on November 7, 1998 for failure to maintain adequate insurance, as was Transferor's charter-party authority (TCP-9003P). (Transferor incorrectly states that he presently holds charter-party authority TCP-9003-P.) There has been no attempt by Transferor to reinstate these authorities. Transferee was notified of these facts by letter from the Rail Safety and Carriers Division.

Since there is no outstanding passenger stage authority, there is nothing to transfer and the application must be dismissed.

### **Comments On Draft Decision**

The draft decision of the Administrative Law Judge in this matter was mailed to the parties in accordance with Pub. Util. Code § 311(g) and Rule 77.1 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure. No comments were received.

### **Findings of Fact**

1. Transferor applied to transfer PSC-9003.
2. PSC-9003 was revoked on November 7, 1998.
3. There is no record of any attempt to reinstate PSC-9003.

### **Conclusions of Law**

1. Transferor is attempting to transfer a revoked certificate.
2. The application must be dismissed.
3. There is no reason to extend the effective date of this order.

## **O R D E R**

**IT IS ORDERED** that:

1. The application to transfer a revoked certificate is dismissed.
2. This proceeding is closed.
