(RESOLUTION AMENDING COMMISSION RECORDS TO REFLECT THE ACQUISITION)
(OF CONTROL OF NORTH AMERICAN VAN LINES, INC., A DELAWARE)
(CORPORATION, BY NORFOLK SOUTHERN CORPORATION UNDER THE)
(EXCLUSIVE AND PLENARY JURISDICTION OF THE INTERSTATE)
(COMMERCE COMMISSION (ICC))

North American Van Lines, Inc. (NAVL), a Delaware corporation (File T-135,539), holds a household goods carrier permit and a highway contract carrier permit.

Norfolk Southern Corporation (NSC), a non-carrier holding company, filed a petition with the ICC under 49 U.S.C. 11344(c) for approval of the acquisition of control of NAVL through the purchase of all outstanding common stock of NAVL.

The ICC approved the acquisition of control of NAVL by NSC in its decision in Finance Docket No. 30500 effective June 12, 1985. We have since been notified by Fritz R. Kahn, counsel for NSC, that the transaction was consummated on June 21, 1985.

Findings of Fact (GREEN)

1. The ICC, having exclusive and plenary jurisdiction, approved the acquisition of control of NAVL by NSC in Finance Docket No. 30500 effective June 12, 1985.

2. The control transaction was consummated on June 21, 1985.

Conclusion of Law

The Commission concludes that its records should reflect the acquisition of control of NAVL by NSC.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The Commission's records shall be amended to reflect the acquisition of control of North American Van Lines, Inc., a Delaware corporation, by Norfolk Southern Corporation, a non-carrier holding company.

2. The Executive Director is directed to cause service of a copy of this Resolution on Fritz R. Kahn, counsel for Norfolk Southern Corporation, 1660 L Street, N.W., Suite 1000, Washington, D.C. 20036.

3. This Resolution is effective today.
