RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE PERIOD OF SUSPENSION FOR FAILURE TO MAINTAIN ON FILE INSURANCE COVERAGE REQUIRED BY GENERAL ORDER NO. 100-SERIES

Highway carriers of property and certain other businesses subject to General Order No. 100-Series are required to maintain evidence of public liability and property damage insurance coverage on file with the Commission.

Upon receipt of an insurance cancellation, the Commission staff suspends the operating authority of the entity involved concurrently with the lapse of insurance coverage. Unless evidence of new insurance coverage is filed within forty-five (45) days of the suspension, the entity's operating authority is then revoked. Because of the difficulty experienced by highway carriers and other regulated businesses in obtaining insurance coverage (see OII 85-12-033), the 45 day suspension period should be extended to ninety (90) days to allow additional time for replacement of insurance coverage before operating authorities are revoked.

IT IS ORDERED that:

The Executive Director is authorized to extend the period during which the operating authorities of highway carriers and other businesses subject to General Order 100-Series are suspended for failure to maintain evidence of insurance on file from 45 days to 90 days before revocation.

This resolution is effective today.
