RESOLUTION 18237 Transportation Division

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(RESOLUTION SUSPENDING AND REVOKING OPERATING AUTHORITY OF) (C & F LIVESTOCK TRANSPORTATION, A CALIFORNIA CORPORATION)

C & F Livestock Transportation, a California corporation (T-67,502), P.O. Box 1338, Oakdale, CA 95361, holds highway contract, livestock, heavy-specialized, tank truck, and agricultural carrier permits and a highway common carrier certificate issued by this Commission.

We were recently informed by the California Franchise Tax Board that the corporate powers, rights and privileges of C & F Livestock Transportation were suspended under the provisions of Section 23301 or 23301.5 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code on November 1, 1985 and have remained in suspension since that date.

Under the circumstances, the Commission finds that the operating authorities issued to C & F Livestock Transportation should be suspended immediately and revoked thirty days from the effective date of this order unless the corporate powers, rights and privileges of C & F Livestock Transportation have been reinstated.

'IT IS ORDERED that:

The above named operating authorities issued to C & F Livestock Transportation are suspended on the effective date of this order and shall be revoked thirty days after the effective date of this order, unless prior to the date of revocation the corporate powers of the carrier are reinstated or the carrier files an application to transfer the authorities to another entity.

Should C & F Livestock Transportation desire to protest this action, a formal application requesting a hearing must be filed in accordance with the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure. Such application will stay the revocation of the carrier's operating authorities.

The Executive Director is directed to cause personal service of a certified copy of this resolution on C & F Livestock Transportation.

The effective date of this order is the date of personal service upon the carrier.
