RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION AVENDING RESOLUTION CE 2-86 BY AUTHORIZING DESIGNATED ENPLOYEES IN THE TRANSPORTATION DIVISION TO EXERCISE POWERS OF ARREST AS A PEACE OFFICER TO ENFORCE ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES CODE

WHEREAS: Chapter 382, Statutes of 1986, added Sections 1034.5 and 1039 to the P.U. Code, making it a misdemeanor to advertise as a passenger stage corporation without having a valid certificate from the Commission, and for such a carrier to advertise without including its PUC identification symbol, respectively; and

WHEREAS: Resolutions CE 2-86 and CE 8-86 authorized designated employees in the Transportation Division who completed the prescribed Penal Code Section 832 training course to exercise powers of arrest of a peace officer and to enforce specified categories of misdemeanor offenses under the P.U. Code; and

WHEREAS: Joe Arroyo, assigned to the Stockton District Office, Compliance Section, completed the mandatory Penal Code 832 training in October, 1985 prior to his transfer to this agency from the Department of Employment and Development on July 1, 1986;

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

- Resolution CE 2-86 is hereby amended to authorize 1. designated employees to exercise additional powers of arrest of a peace officer to enforce Sections 1034.5 and 1039 of the Public Utilities Code.
- Joe Arroyo is hereby authorized to exercise powers 2. of arrest of a peace officer to enforce the specified provisions of the P.U. Code.

The effective date of this resolution shall be January 1, 1987.
